Helpful Hints

- Hours of operation are subject to change.
- Heightened security should be expected at many sites. Please be sure not to bring any questionable items, such as large bags, weapons, sharp items, or pepper spray. Cameras are allowed at most locations.
- If you get lost on the Mall, remember that it forms a cross. The Capitol, Washington Monument, and Lincoln Monument form the long line, and the Jefferson Monument, Washington Monument, and White House form the short line.
- Remember that the museums close around 5pm, so during the summer it may be best to see the monuments at night and go to the museums during the day.
- Make sure to bring good walking shoes and an umbrella.
- Parking is limited. Visitors are encouraged to use the Metro rail system (www.wmata.com) or other forms of transit.
